Smart, hard working toget financial freedom

THE road to financial freedom can be resolved if only an individual not only work hard, but work smart. This was stated by Aaron Sim, the CEO of Wealth Mentors, an education mentoring organisation, during a seminar held at Rizqun International Hotel here yesterday.

Wealth Mentors is an organisation that helps people obtain skills to create a lifetime of infinite wealth and abundance, and helping them to move closer to their goals of true financial independence. "I have been to many wealth management seminars and spent so much money until I met Mirriam MacWilliams," he said.

Mirriam MacWilliams is the chief options trainer of Wealth Mentors. She started of with US\$10,000 (B\$14,100) when she became involved with the stock market, and has made over \$2 million in a span of two years.

Aaron spoke of the strategies in option trading and briefly explained the formulas and tips on how to achieve financial freedom. He said that the wealth formula consists of constant investment where you must be able to put your money aside on a regular basis and advised patience about wanting money soon and fast. "Making money doesn't just happen overnight, you must be able to give it time to grow," he said

He underlined one of the main components of obtaining wealth was knowledge. Knowledge is also one of the components that lead to the success of the wealth formula. "Knowing the right kind of information is the key to higher returns."

He mentioned that option trading is a much better option than buying stock as there are higher returns and smaller risks. He said that before an individual makes money, they must be prepared to know how much they will lose.

He highlighted a comment by Warren Buffett who is regarded as one of the world's greatest investors and is the largest shareholder and CEO of Berkshire Hathaway. "More millionaires are created from the stock market," he said.

There will be four day intensive seminars for people who are interested in how the United States stock market works in Singapore and Malaysia in October and December.

A 25-year-old tuition teacher, who has entered the seminar for the very first time, said he is going to consider option trading. "I attended this seminar so I can make money. So far, I have been enticed," he said. The Brunei Times
